# 01 CLEAN



Maintaining your countertop will strengthen the surface and increase its lifespan. We recommend that you wipe the surface with clean water to avoid hardened stains.

e.g. Stagnant water accumulates around the sink, causing scale.

## MAIN TAINANCE



When cleaning countertops, use a non-abrasive sponge with a pH-balanced cleaner and warm water regularly to maintain LEVEL

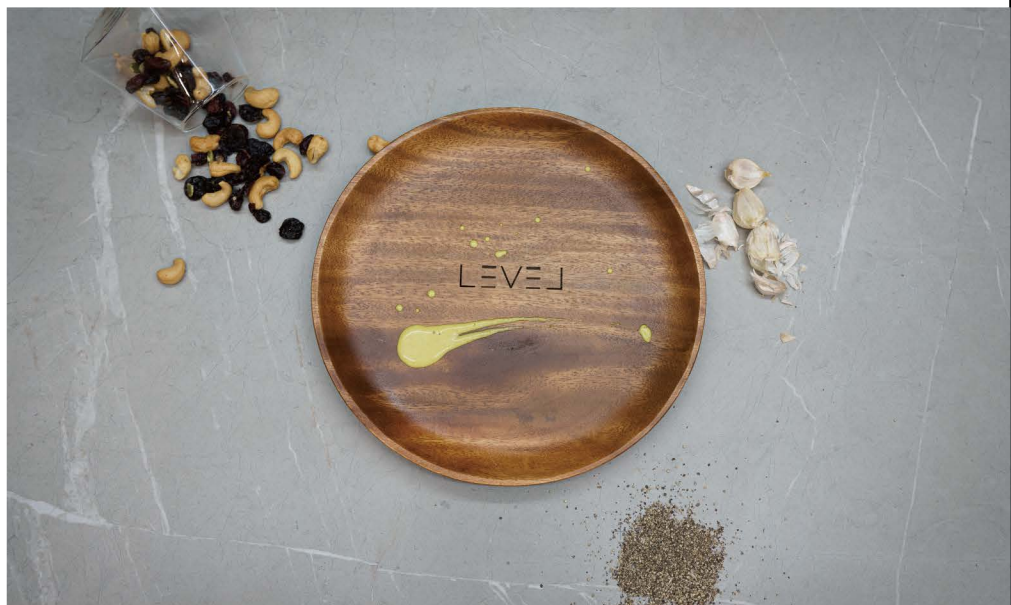
Note: Do not use scouring sponges with stainless steel or abrasive sponges; these can scratch the LEVEL surface.

Never use a stain remover with iron oxide and hydrofluoric acid, as it will damage the countertop.

## SUGGESTION



If you would like to use Bleach or Scrub cleaner creams paste to clean your countertops, we have a sample for each customer and recommend that you evaluate the sample first.





Below are some simple guides on keeping your countertops in good condition.

lipstick , Coffee , Tea , Fruit Juice , Wine , Oil , Dirt

3M Marine multipurpose cleaner (p.1)

Spray on countertop and wait three minutes than use  
sponge(no Abrasive sponges) wipe lightly

Metal debris , Wax , Aluminum scratches , soap scum , pencil marks

ECOLAB Lemon Eze Cream Cleanser (p.2)

Use the cleanser on the dirty place and wipe  
it with clean water

Residual Adhesive , Grease stains

3M™ Adhesive Cleaner (p.3)

Use the c leaner on the dirty place and wait two  
minutes the use sponge(no Abrasive sponges) wipe lightly
